

## Complications of Vaginal Repair

### Anterior Repair

- Damage to bladder
- Damage to ureter
- Vesico-vaginal fistula
- Uretero-vaginal fistula
- Laparotomy maybe necessary
- Urologist may need to be involved
- Re-implantation ureter
- Ureteric stent

- Urinary symptoms including incontinence**

- Allergic reaction to antibiotics**

- Blood transfusion rarely required**

- Recurrence of prolapse**

- Urinary Tract infection**

### Posterior Repair

- Damage to bowel
- Colorectal Surgeon may need to be involved
- vaginal fistula
- Temporary colostomy
- Faecal incontinence, if damage to sphincter

- Hematoma**

- Abscess
